



General Health and Hygiene Protocol for 2021-2022 School Year Programming
(Updated August 2021)

GENERAL REQUIREMENT TO COMPLY WITH ALL PROTOCOLS

All employees, contractors, vendors, and visitors will be required to follow all Health and Safety Protocols while performing work on behalf of the District and/or on a District property.

PRACTICING GOOD HYGIENE

All employees will follow the following strategies to reduce the risk of transmission:

- Wash hands frequently using soap and water for at least 20 seconds, particularly after coming into contact with high-touch surfaces, such as doorknobs, handrails, and commonly used equipment; before and after touching masks; and when using the restroom.
- Use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol if hand washing is not feasible. Hand sanitizer is provided in all buildings.
- Cough/sneeze into sleeves, preferably into the elbow. When using a tissue, discard it properly and clean/sanitize hands immediately.
- Avoid touching the face, particularly eyes, nose, and mouth because these are the entry points for the virus.
- Avoid using other employees' cell phones, desks, offices, or other work tools and equipment.
